Collection Reminders

** ALL garbage should be bagged and tied shut

-single bags should not weigh over 50 lbs. You are allowed up to 90 gallons of trash

**Call ahead of time if there will be any extra non-household trash/items. Extra charges may apply

** Have garbage/recycling out for pick up by 8:00 A.M. the day of your pick up

** Recycling – bagged in paper bags or loose (NO PLASTIC BAGS)

-large carts should not be used for loose recycling. Please use smaller cans or bins that can be lifted by hand

** Recyclable items include:

NO PLASTIC BAGS

-plastic #1, #2, #5 only (NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC WRAPPERS, PACKING MATERIAL, ETC.)

-ALL PLASTIC BAGS & FOAM PRODUCTS SHOULD BE THROWN IN TRASH (take out containers, foam cups, egg & meat foam containers, packing material, etc.)

-glass containers/bottles (no plate glass, mirrors, light bulbs, window glass)

-aluminum/tin cans

-bottles, containers, and cans should be rinsed out and empty (labels can stay on)

-newspaper, magazines, junk mail (paper should be bagged in paper bags or loose)

-cardboard MUST be emptied of all packing material and flattened down, NO PACKING MATERIAL

-ALL packing materials inside cardboard boxes should be thrown in trash
